ORDER

The above-entitled matter came before the Honorable Leonardo Castro, Judge of District Court, administratively on November 26, 2025. Plaintiff requested that this Court issue a decision on Plaintiff's request for a Temporary Restraining Order prior to a hearing. The Court, upon all the files, records, and proceedings herein, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, now makes the following Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Because the St. Paul City Ordinance 25-65 "is designed to take effect only upon the repeal, amendment, or judicial invalidation of state preemption laws that currently prohibit local regulation of firearms,"¹ Plaintiff has not shown "that immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result to the applicant before the [parties] can be heard in opposition."² Therefore, Plaintiff's request for a Temporary Restraining Order is **DENIED**.
2. This matter shall be set for a hearing on Plaintiff's request for a Temporary Injunction under Minn. R. Civ. P. 65.02 on **December 17, 2025, at 2:30 PM via Zoom**. Defendant shall appear at that hearing.

4. Plaintiff may submit a reply on or before **December 15, 2025.**
